CHAMPION OF THE INDUSTRY AWARD

The Champion of the Industry Award honours individuals who have made an outstanding contribution to the Australian cider industry over a prolonged period of time. Cider Australia is proud to present this Award to Max Allen.

Max Allen is a passionate, unwavering and active supporter of the Australian cider industry. Born in Bristol, Max grew up with cider and has written about it since the mid 1990's, way before many of Australia's craft cider brands were conceived.

An award-winning drinks journalist and author, Max's ability and willingness to communicate about cider is second to none. What sets him apart is that he is also an expert on everything from growing apples, making cider, tasting and selling cider to the complete history of cider. One day you might find Max scooping up fallen apples on the side of the road to make into his next trial ferment, and the next day wining and dining dignitaries at a five-star restaurant – and if publication timelines permit he might do both on the same day.

Max has been instrumental in supporting Cider Australia and the Australian Cider Awards from the very beginning. With a strong understanding of the industry and its people, Max was part of the movement to form a united national cider association. He was a judge at the very first cider show held in Lenswood in 2007 and took on the role of chief judge at the first 'official' Australian Cider Awards held in Orange in 2011. Max has continued to participate in various guises since then – judging, stewarding and hosting international guests and cider events.

More recently, Max wrote the Australian Cider Guide and scripted and co-starred in a series of educational videos about Australian Craft Cider. Both excellent educational pieces that are made with integrity, just like 100% Australian Grown craft cider and Max himself.

On presenting this Award to Max, the Australian cider community is in 100% agreement.
