
MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

CHIEF JUDGE'S REPORT

It's been another exciting year for the Australian Cider Awards, and I'm thrilled to have been in the chief judge role for the second year running.

One of the standout aspects of this year's competition is the clear improvement in cider quality. We saw a higher number of bronze medals and fewer entries receiving no medals compared to last year. This speaks to the rising standards across the industry, with most entries offering a solid drinking experience. This improvement also made the judges' task of assigning medals all the more challenging – a good problem to have in my book!



This year the Traditional Cider and Fruit Cider classes punched above their weight, claiming almost half of the gold medals awarded. The judges were

particularly impressed at how skilful cider makers are becoming at integrating other fruits into their ciders.

As always, the judging process was highly professional. All cider samples were blind-coded, ensuring a fair and impartial evaluation. Our judging panel was incredibly diverse, with expertise ranging from sensory analysis, drinks writing, cider and winemaking, hospitality, juice processing, and experienced spirits judges. It's this breadth of knowledge that allows us to assess each cider from multiple perspectives, ensuring a well-rounded assessment.

I'd like to extend a huge thanks to all our judges, stewards, and the organising committee for making this year's competition a success. It's always a privilege to be part of such a professional and passionate team. Here's to another year of celebrating the best ciders from across Australia and beyond!

BEST SINGLE VARIETAL CIDER

David Pickering Memorial Trophy

Cider Australia has established a new perpetual trophy this year because the number of high quality, single varietal ciders being made in Australia and entered in the Awards has reached a critical mass. We are excited that the Australian cider industry has reached this stage of development.

Cider Australia has named the Best Single Varietal Cider trophy in honour of industry champion David Pickering who passed away in July this year.

The Best Single Varietal – David Pickering Memorial Trophy is a mark of remembrance of David's contribution to the industry. In the collective words of the Australian cider community, "David was a true gentleman and cider pioneer whose expertise and generosity shaped Australian craft cider".

The trophy is sponsored by Orange cider producers Incy Wincy Cyder and Small Acres Cyder.

Vale David Pickering

David Pickering was a researcher and cider apple orchardist from Huntley, NSW. He was a highly regarded expert on cider apples with a passion for educating and connecting people.

The technical advice David generously provided to many current and prospective cider apple growers and the unique resources he created and shared through his website CiderOz have benefited the industry greatly.

David was instrumental in the establishment of Cider Australia and the Australian Cider Awards more than a decade ago, and was awarded Cider Australia's Champion of the Industry Award in 2018 in recognition of his outstanding contribution to the Australian cider industry.

David passed away in July 2024.
